♂, ♀ as illustrated. Also figured is a ♂ from Taiwan. This species which can be easily confused with *S.anna* may be distinguished from that species by a close examination of the f.w.v. In *lilaea* the diagonally placed brown central band is very poorly ornamented with silver-grey crescents and patches. The opposite holds for *anna*. Further, on the h.w.v. of *anna* there is much greyish-pink scaling at or about the anal angle margin, whilst on *lilaea*, this greyish-pink scaling is absent from the orange ground colour.
