

Overall, the iridescent blue dorsal wing colour of *Lazulina* **gen.n.** species readily distinguishes them from most euptychiines, except for females in comparison with several species of *Chloreuptychia* and *Pseudeuptychia*. *Lazulina* **gen.n.** can be distinguished by the presence of yellowish or reddish brown scaling within the dark band posterior of the VFW apical ocellus, and by the VHW ocellus in M_3 - M_2 being basally displaced in comparison with that in M_2 - M_1 .
